Wear appropriate footwear for a beach clean dependent on weather and location.



Check the local tide times before you begin.

Go with others or make sure you tell someone where you are going and how long you will be.

Check your surroundings and beware of slippery rocks and busy roads.

Stay safe – avoid any needles and do not pick up anything with human waste (like nappies), electrical items, or anything which might contain chemicals. If you're not sure

What it is, don't pick it up.
Report any of the above items or anything you believe to be dangerous to the local council or landowner.

If possible take separate collection bags for regular litter and that which can be recycled.

Always make sure that you thoroughly wash your hands after taking part in a beach clean.
