

Top Tips for Litter Picks!

- Please ensure all those taking part in the litter pick are suitably attired for the location which the litter pick is taking place, i.e. sensible footwear, visible clothing, wearing the gloves provided in the kit.
- If you are carrying out your litter picking on or near a beach, check tide times before you begin.
- Go with others or make sure you tell someone where you are going and how long you will be.
- Check your surroundings – cliff bases, washes and beware of slippery rocks, busy roads.
- Stay safe – leave any needles and do not pick up anything with human waste (like nappies), electrical items, or anything which might contain chemicals. If you're not sure what it is, don't pick it up.
- Report any of the above items or anything you believe to be dangerous to the local council or landowner.
- If possible have separate collection bags for regular litter and that which can be recycled.
- Wash your hands. Always make sure that you thoroughly wash hands after litter picking.
- The Deep is not responsible for individual or group safety when carrying out a litter pick. Please carry out your own risk assessments.
- Keep to public land/pathways or gain permission to access private land.



Using the Handihoop



Step 1

Firmly grip the foam handle and tab to release the retainer cord.



Step 2

Fit the bag then hold the retainer cord in place and guide around the circumference into the cord channel.



Step 3

Hold the handle and locate the retainer cord around the full circumference of the hoop, ensuring the bag is secured in place and you can access the foam handle.
